Discerning Staff

For the past several months, I have been writing and speaking to you about our work of discerning in terms of church staffing. In May, we began a discernment process around this issue. After the first phase (exploring the options), we began to develop a listening strategy to involve the wider congregation as well as outside sources. Just as we began to put this together, we came into contact with Clifton Davis. Clif is a doctoral student at Ball State and was introduced to us by a mutual friend. After talking to Clif, it seemed that God may be bringing him into our midst. We paused our discernment process to



enter a mini-discernment process around Clif's relationship to our church. After extensive conversation and trial experiences, we felt that God was leading us to invite Clif to serve in an interim capacity while we continued to discern God's plan for our church (in terms of staffing).

Have we completed the discernment process? – We are not finished discerning our church staffing plan. As we discovered in the initial stage, the issue is complex and will take time to sort out. We will need time to hear and discern how God is working. We have not concluded that our future staff will be in the area of music. We have great needs in other areas. We need to appropriately consider all options.

Will Clif be full-time? – Clif is a full-time student. He will serve our church on a part-time basis. His primary responsibilities will be planning worship and working with the choir and praise team.

How long will Clif be here? – While we don't know for sure, our initial contract with Clif will be for six months. This will give us time to evaluate and discern his role. This will also give Clif time to assess his responsibility in light of his studies at Ball State.

Please continue to pray for God's leading in terms of church staffing. While we did not anticipate calling an interim, God provided and led us in this direction for now. We will gather on **Sunday**, **July 13** for a congregational vote on this decision.

During this time, the Lord directed her paths to Israel, and in 1998, she became an Israeli/American citizen.

Lori Kate would say that after looking back on her life of musical and evangelistic training; God was preparing her for a bigger purpose which allowed her the opportunity and privilege of living in a foreign country, speaking a different language and raising a family in God's Holy Land. Besides being a full-time wife and a loving mom to her 14 and 9 year old boys, she is in high demand as a music teacher in the Jezreel Valley. She teaches clarinet, saxophone, flute, piano and recorder.
