I am sure that card companies are happy to see this month roll around. However, love is more than candy, cards, and cupids. Love is ultimately expressed in the *agape* love of Jesus. John reminds us,

(John 15:13 NIV11) Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

February (this year) includes the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday, *February 18*, marks the six-week preparation for Easter. As a Southern Baptist kid, I did not celebrate or acknowledge the season. May we see past the superficial hearts of Valentine's Day and look toward God's heart for us.

(Romans 5:8 NIV11) But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Life Line Screening

First Baptist Church is pleased to offer a preventive health event. Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, will host their affordable, non-invasive and painless health screenings on February 24. Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to:
