#### **Summer Kids Meals Program to be FBC outreach**

First Baptist Church will be part of a summer outreach opportunity, and we quickly need to know who will help!

Partnering organizations, Chartwells K-12 food service, Muncie Community Schools, Open Door Health Services and FBC will provide free lunches for children at FBC for seven weeks, from **June 7-July 22** at the church. Through a U.S. Department of Agriculture grant, low-income youth and children under 18 will be able to get a free lunch. Many of Muncie's children do not eat a lunch in the summertime, according to Open Door employees.

"Chartwells approached Open Door," said Pastor Wade Allen, "and they wanted to participate but didn't have a suitable serving site with a suitable kitchen. So Open Door approached us and after we looked into the program and queried everyone on the Church Coordinating Council, it was agreed that this is something we should do."

There are three other feeding sites in Muncie this summer, all on the south side of town. The site at our church will be able to serve near-downtown children as they use our lower auditorium each day.

Every day, Chartwells personnel will bring in the lunch including a cold sandwich, vegetables, fruit and milk and take back anything that is unused. On Mondays and Thursdays Open Door personnel will help serve the food, visit with the children and provide a simple activity for them. FBC volunteers will be responsible for Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays, and help with brief activities while children wait in the Lower Auditorium to be picked up.

"Our CCT believes we should use our church building not only for ourselves but to serve others," said Wade. "This is a wonderful opportunity. At the end of the summer, we will evaluate whether we would get involved next summer if the program is repeated."

James Martin, Outreach Coordinator, and Wes Russell, Second Service-at-Large Coordinator, are in charge of recruiting volunteers.

"We need people to let us know immediately (before May 2) that they can help, even if they do not know their exact schedules until closer to the time of the feeding program," said Wes. "We can create a detailed schedule as June approaches. However, we have to know right now that there are people who can and will serve during the 11:30-12:30 time slot on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Our names need to be turned in and people need to fill out some paperwork relating to criminal checks. We will have participation sheets on two Sundays, April 24 and May 1." CCT will discuss whether partnering with a different community group might allow food to be brought in for parents of the children. In addition, there is discussion with Second Harvest Food Bank to see whether occasional food giveaways for the families might be scheduled during this time.

We ask that you prayerfully consider how you can help as our church reaches out to some of the most needy families in our community. If you have any questions about this, please see Wade Allen, Molly Flodder, Wes Russell or James Martin.
